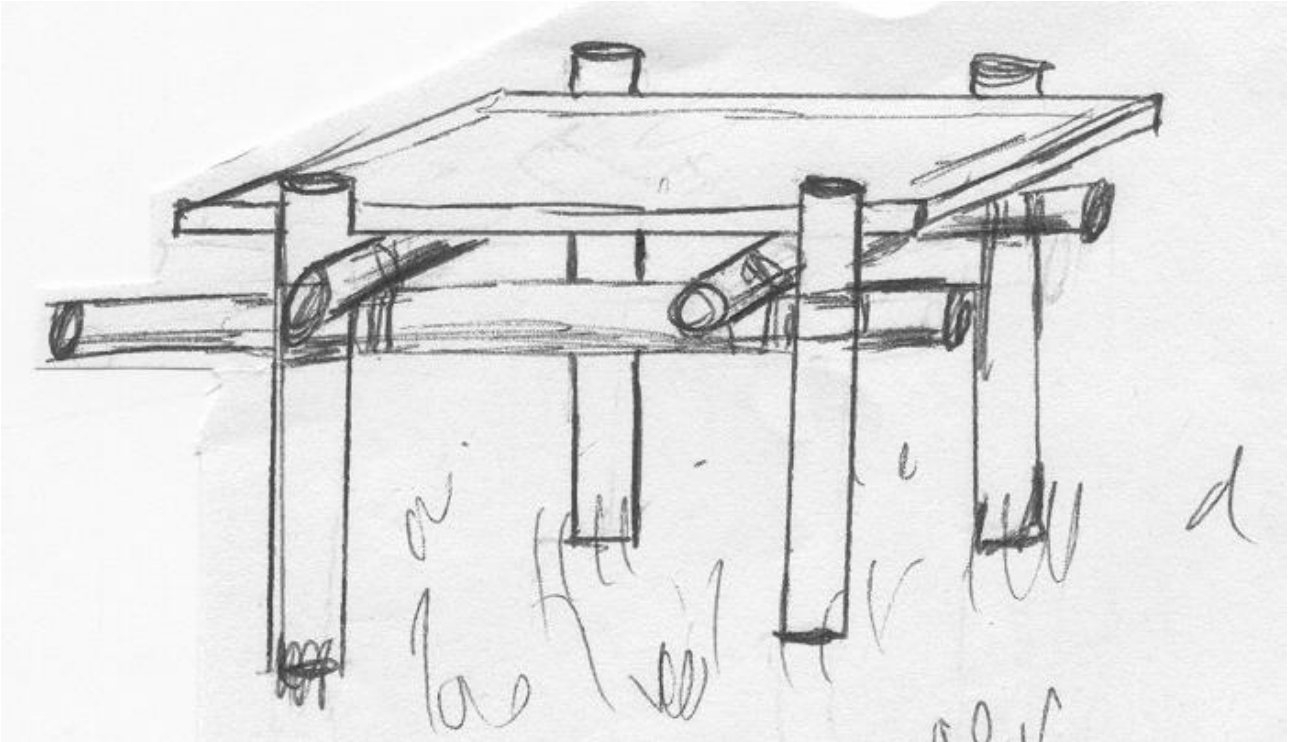


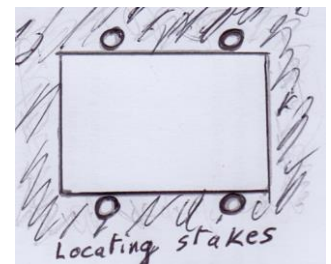
Altar Fire



Decide where you want the fire, on flat open ground in you kitchen area, not under trees (smoke and heat will damage them), downwind of your tents and dining shelters, and near your wood pile.

1 Lay the metal tray on the ground where you want the fire.
2 Knock in 4 stakes 2 on each side of the long sides of the tray. Make sure they are firm and the tops all at about the same height, remove the tray.

3 **Very firmly** square lash two longer poles in place on the **longer** sides about, 10 cms down, make sure they are level. These are what hold the fire up.



4 Put the shorter poles on top of the longer ones and square lash to the **stakes**.
5 place the metal tray on the shorter poles and cover with about 5 cms of soil, this keep the tray cool and stops it bending with the heat of the fire.

The tops of the stakes keep the tray in place and if the lashings on the shorter poles do char the longer poles will still hold.

If the stakes have not gone in far and may be loose lash more poles diagonally between the stakes, on all 4 sides if needed.
